Pupils are carefully monitored during each session by their tutor who will instantly pick up on mistakes and misconceptions. We then provide quality modelling using the in built virtual whiteboard tools. If deeper intervention is required, our tutors will prepare specific materials for the following session. This creates a truly personalised programme for each learner.

Since all work is captured instantly on our website, it is easy for pupils, teachers and tutors to remain connected which is a vital component of any successful tutoring programme. Since pupils have 24/7 access, it means they can continue to practise in their own time and our Tutors actively encourage this. Teachers can get a snapshot of progress at any time and Tutors can refer back to previous learning to support their planning.

All sessions are delivered via Zoom and recorded for safeguarding purposes. If pupils are working in school or from home, we strongly recommend that they use headphones to avoid distractions. They should also be working with either a tablet or computer device coupled with pen and paper or mini whiteboard. Group sizes are 3 on average but this may vary due to the needs of the individual students.


Mr Andrew Elwell
